Culture

The Museum of agriculture

The Museum is located near the grammar school gymnasium nad Štolou and the Museum of technology on Letná in The Capital City of Prague. From outside the building is clad in brick and this building have also three floors.

The institution was established on 28. 9. 1918 by creating association Czech museum of agriculture. Soon after the establishment of the republic, the association was transformed into the Czechoslovak Museum of Agriculture, an institute for the study and advancement of the countryside, and became, especially thanks to the excellent museological work of Josef Kazimour and with the extraordinary political support of Antonín Švehla and other personalities, one of the most progressive museum institutions of the First Republic. However, the institutionalization of the museum was preceded by older attempts.

In the museum we can see many exhibitions. In underground was exhibition of tractors, in the first floor was a forest and fishing. In second and third was hunting, water in land scape, agriculture and gastronomy and last one was a roof where is good view of Prague and some plants.

In my opinion the best exhibition was s exhibition of tractors, because we can see here lots of tractors which was used in past and lot of their brands.
